

NH White - Yellow; Hispanic - Red; NH Black - Blue


NH-Black – 3 (1,3,13)



Dallas. I presume many are in agreement of this and have moved that area north of Singleton back into Old District 6 in new maps. BB









































The new map created a **Kessler and Downtown Dallas District as number 8** on the new map. It creates a community with much more economic and ethnic/racial mix in common.
