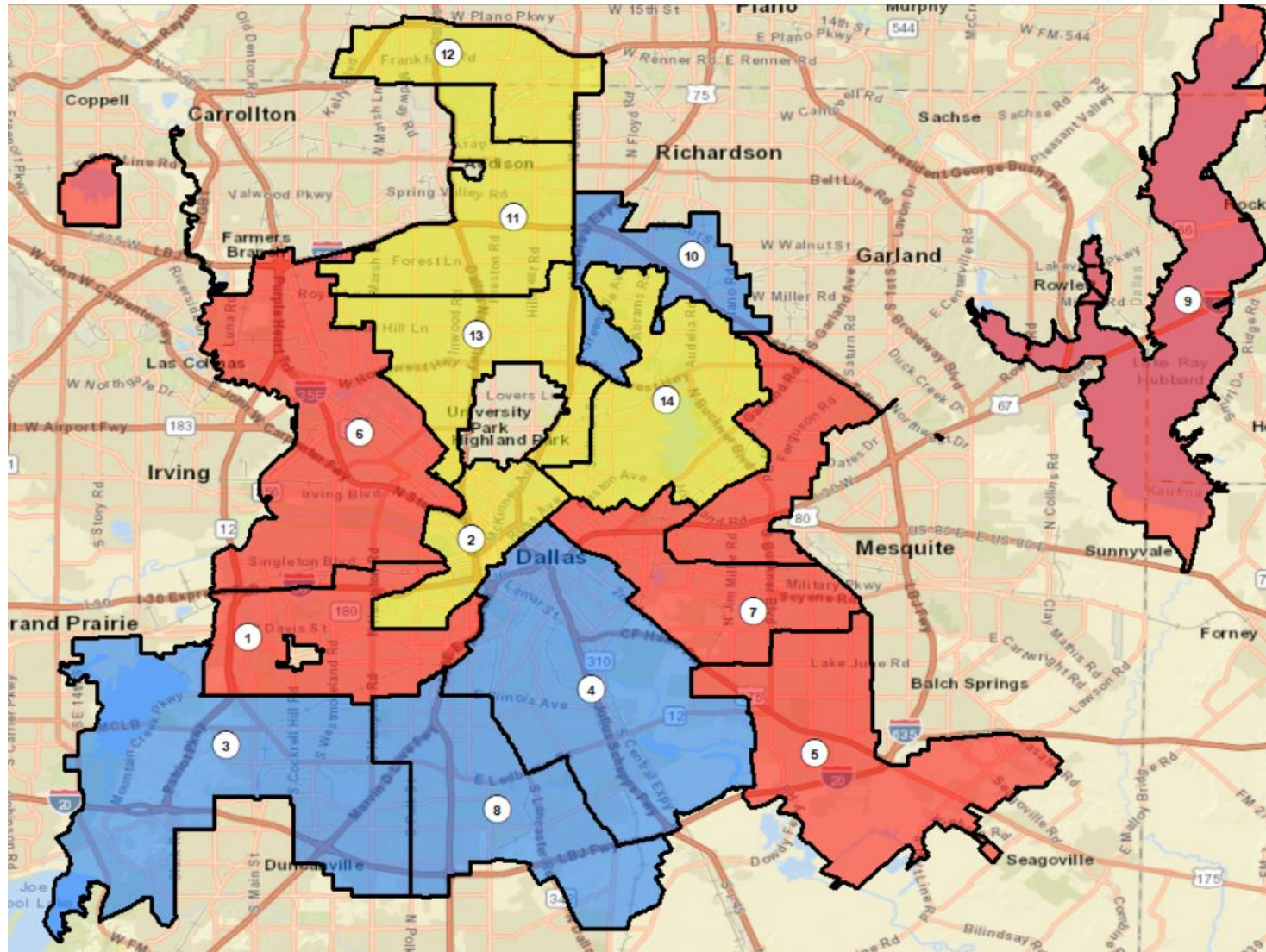
- The Commissioners are encouraged to review all map plans that have been submitted for the week, as some submitters may decline to present.

- Max Dev – 8.97%
- # of Minority Districts – 9
- NH-Black – 4
(3, 4, 8, 10)
- Hispanic – 5
(1, 5, 6, 7, 9)
- Districts 10 & 13 have low compactness scores
- # of neighborhood associations split – 50 out of 443



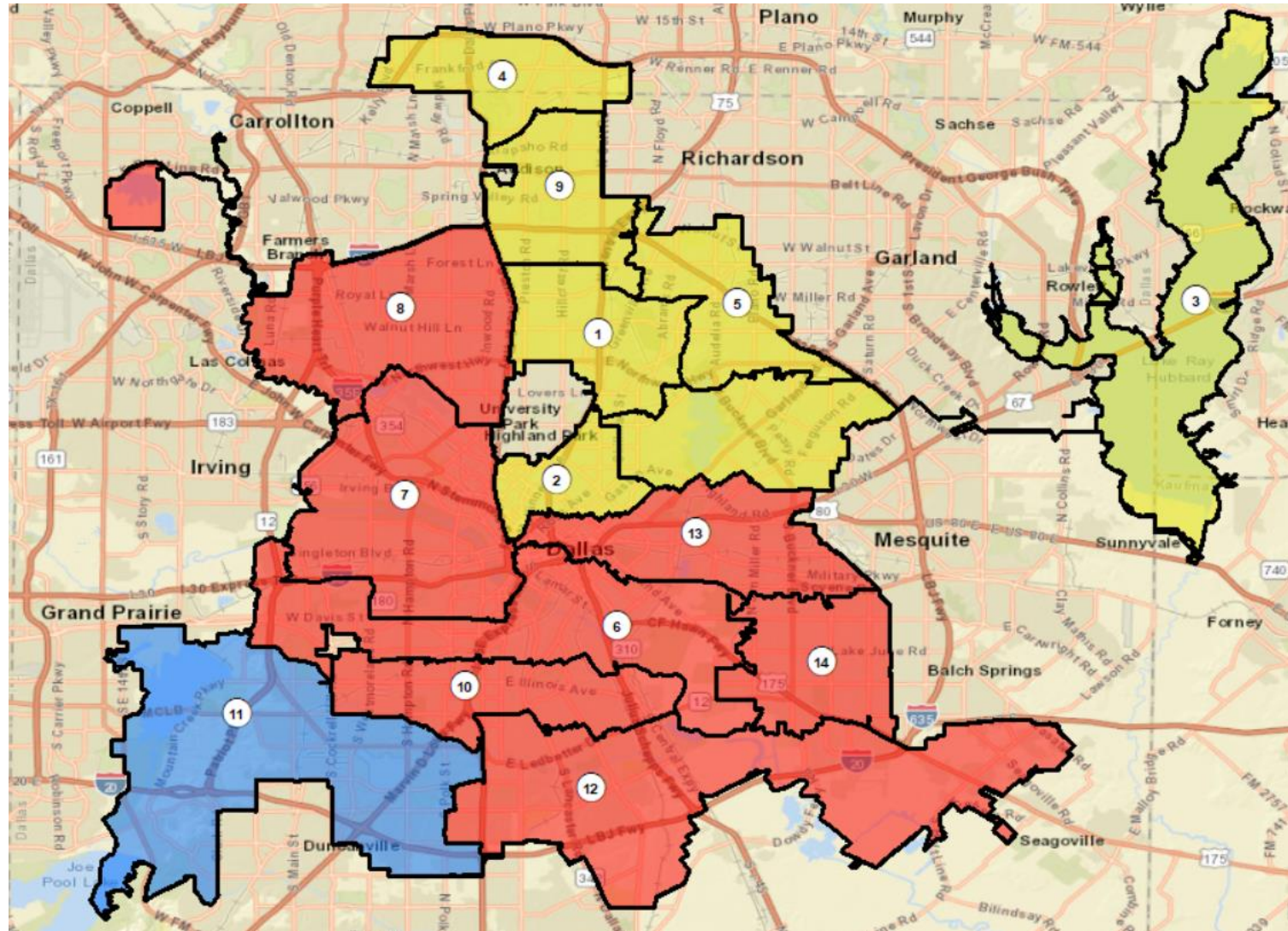
NH White – Yellow; Hispanic – Red; NH Black – Blue



Map Submittal Update – COD-016-SophieK



- Max Dev – 4.06%
- # of Minority Districts – 8
- NH-Black – 1 (11)
- Hispanic – 7
(6, 7, 8, 10, 12, 13, 14)
- Districts 6, 11, 12 have low compactness scores
- # of neighborhood associations split – 69 out of 443
