- 1. Public Speakers
  - The Redistricting Commission had three public speaker for their March 21, 2022 Redistricting Commission Regular Meeting.

- 2. Approval of March 7, 2022 Minutes
  - The minutes from the March 7, 2022 Redistricting Commission Regular Meeting were approved by the commission.
- 3. BRIEFING ITEM: Map Submittal Update
  - ARCBridge Consultants provided an update on the total number of maps submitted to-date related to the redistricting process and the criteria they use in reviewing map submissions.
  - General questions related to map submissions were asked by the Commission and answered by ARCBridge.
- 4. ACTION ITEM: Map Presentations, Discussion & Voting
  - The Commission was presented with map submission COD-017 by three members of the Commission. This Commission members provided an overview of their submission, including changes and what makes their map unique and different.
    - A motion was made to move map submission COD-017 into the Commission's inventory for further consideration. The Commission held general discussion on the map submission COD-017.
    - The motion was passed by the Commission and map submission COD-017 was moved into the Commission's inventory for further consideration during future meetings.
  - The Commission was presented with map submission COD-018 by an individual of the Community. This individual provided an overview of their submission, including changes and what makes their map unique and different.
    - A motion was made to move map submission COD-018 into the Commission's inventory for further consideration. The Commission held general discussion on the map submission COD-018.
    - The motion did not pass and map submission COD-015 did not move into the Commission's inventory for further consideration.
  - The individual responsible for map submission COD-019 elected to not present their submission to the Commission. The Commission did not receive a presentation on map submission COD-019 and no action was taken by the Commission.
- 5. ACTION ITEM: Map Selection Process Discussion & Approval
  - Chair Jesse Oliver provided a brief introduction on the outline of the next phase of the Map Selection Process.
  - After some discussion by the Commission, the decision was made to table the item until the next regular meeting, scheduled to take place on Monday, March 28, 2022 at 3:30 P.M.
